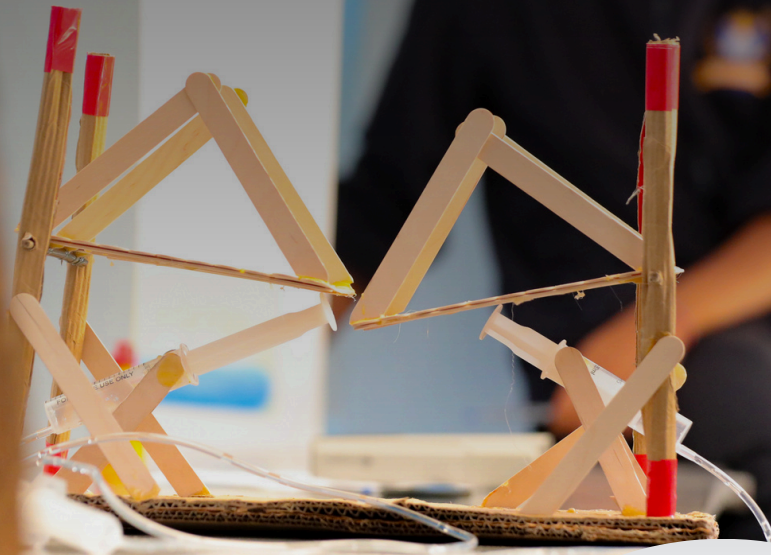

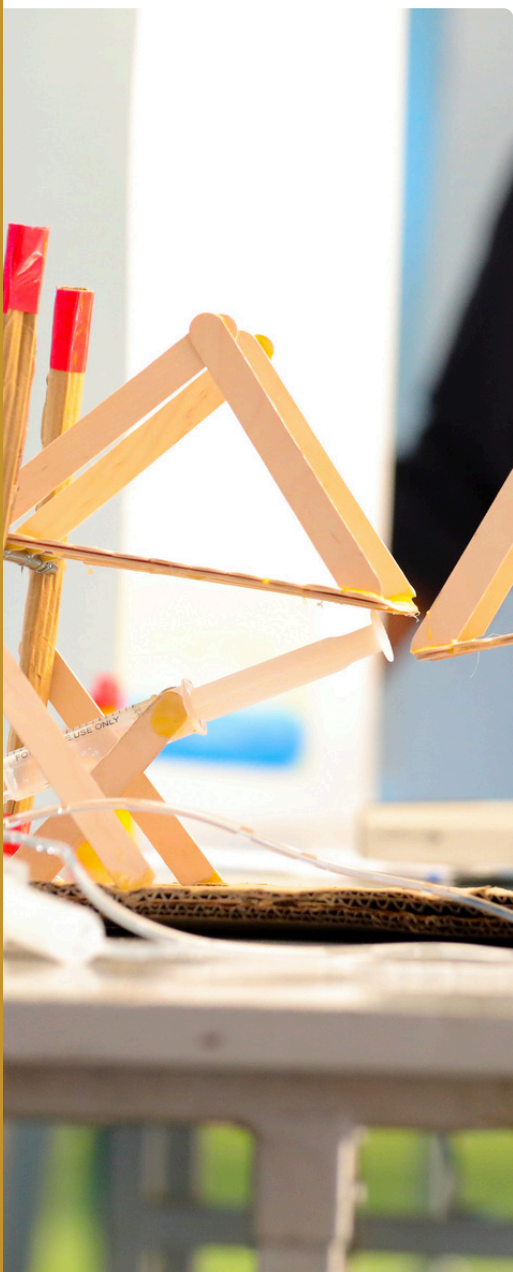

OPEN HOUSE

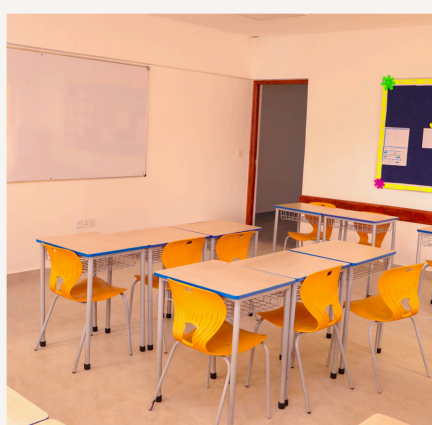
31st January 2026

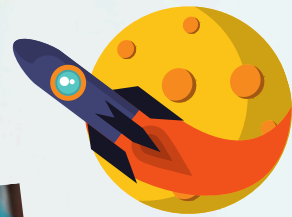
