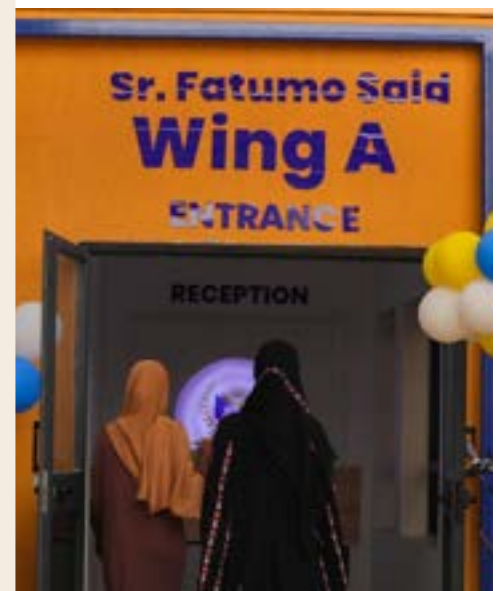
31st January 2026
